There is close collaboration between gastroenterology and hepatology, surgery, transplant surgery, nutrition, radiology, interventional cardiology and others. We are part of the intestinal failure working group in Germany and the NITE (Network of Intestinal Failure and Intestinal Transplant in Europe) group of ESPGHAN (European Society for Paediatric Gastroenterology Hepatology and Nutrition).
