New Children's Hospital, University of Helsinki, Helsinki University Hospital

Our new children's hospital building offering modern diagnostic and interventional facilities was completed in September 2018. We have 12 operating theaters, pediatric intensive care unit and neonatal intensive care unit attached serving Finland's largest women's hospital with nearly 20 000 live births/year. We offer all aspects of neonatal and pediatric surgical care and are responsible for organ transplantations, cardiac surgery, hepatobiliary surgery, intestinal failure, vascular malformations and complex reconstructive surgery in all of Finland. Our pediatric surgical staff includes 7 general pediatric surgeons, 2 pediatric urologists and 4 cardiac surgeons as well as pediatric neurosurgeons, orthopedic surgeons and plastic surgeons. We perform active academic research and interventional clinical trials on variety of pediatric surgical conditions.

Different programs are available for one-week visit in Helsinki including multidisciplinary rounds on wards and intensive care units, interdisciplinary meetings with radiologists and pathologists, surgeries and procedures and follow-up visits in outpatient clinics. Daily schedules depend on individual programs.
