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What are ERNs?

European Reference Networks (ERNs) are virtual networks bringing together healthcare providers across Europe to tackle complex or rare medical conditions requiring highly specialised treatment and a concentration of knowledge and resources.

They have members across the majority of EU Member States and work closely with patient advocacy groups to ensure that patients' voices are heard at all levels within ERNs.

They also run regular education & training activities targeting patients and clinicians.
